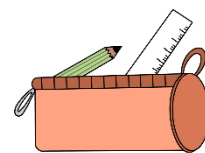


# HOW MANY... there are or there is

	THERE IS	THERE ARE
Affirmative	<i>There is</i> one pencil on the table.	<i>There are</i> five pencils on the table.
Questions	<i>Is there</i> an apple in the lunchbox ?	<i>Are there</i> two apples in the lunchbox ?
Negative	<i>There isn't</i> one book in the schoolbag.	<i>There aren't</i> three books in the schoolbag.
Short Answers	Yes, <i>there is</i> . No, <i>there isn't</i> .	Yes, <i>there are</i> . No, <i>there aren't</i> .

*How many* pencilcases *are there* ?

- *There is* one pencilcase.



*How many* books *are there* ?

- *There are* four books.



*Are there* four donuts ?

-No, *there aren't*. *There is* one donut.
